

Rules and organization of state final exams of CTU FTS held in the period 10.06.2026 – 19.06.2026

These rules are intended for students, supervisors of bachelor's and master's thesis and managers for education of institutes according to the currently valid directive for the implementation of bachelor's and master's study programs

In the period from 10.06.2026 to 19.06.2026, state final exams will be held for students of the CTU in Prague, Faculty of Transportation Sciences, who are scheduled to submit their bachelor's thesis on 12.05.2026 and who do not submit a "Postponement of term of taking FSE and of submission of thesis" according to the dean's current directive.

Submitting final theses by students into the KOS system is done electronically. This submission requirement affects processes at individual departments / institute. Therefore, in addition to these organizational rules and schedule, the submission processes are described in detail in the superior document [ČVUT_MP_2023_06_V05_20251031-cvutmp202306v05.pdf](#) – Methodological guideline for assigning, submitting, archiving and access to bachelor's and master's theses.

Students who received their thesis assignment before February 17, 2025 (the decisive date) and have an "old paper assignment" must include this in their final thesis. However, students also have an electronic assignment in the KOS system, created based on the original paper one. **Both assignments must be included in the submitted thesis.**

General information and notifications:

Students are required to adhere to the ethical principles for creating final theses, as outlined in the Methodological guideline on Adherence to Ethical Principles in Preparation of Graduation Theses [ČVUT MP 2024_02_V01](#). At the beginning of their bachelor's thesis the students shall quote the following declarations, together with date and their signature:

- a) "I do not have a compelling reason against the use of this schoolwork within the intention of § 60 of the Act No. 121/2000 Coll., on Copyright and Rights Related to Copyright and on Amendment to Certain Acts (Copyright Act)." (Provided the final work was not assigned as undisclosed in accordance with Clause 15, subsection 11 of the Dean's Guideline)
- b) "I declare that I have elaborated this thesis independently using information sources listed in the bibliography in accordance with the Methodological Instruction on the observance of ethical principles in the preparation of university final theses and the Framework rules for the use of artificial intelligence at CTU for study and pedagogical purposes in bachelors and master study."

All final thesis (provided they were not assigned as undisclosed in accordance with Clause 15, subsection 11 of the Dean's Guideline) defended after 1st January 2014 are available for download in electronic form at <https://dspace.cvut.cz/handle/10467/3456?locale-attribute=en>

All final theses are submitted electronically through the KOS student information system, in accordance with CTU Methodological Guideline [ČVUT_MP_2023_06_V05_20251031-cvutmp202306v05.pdf](#).

The graduation ceremony shall be held on Tuesday, 22 September 2026. The exact time shall be posted on the website of the faculty in advance.

The next master's studies FSE shall be held in January 2027 and the next bachelor's studies FSE shall be held in September 2026.
