

Enrolment for summer semester of the academic year of 2025-2026 for the students at the CTU FTS

08. 12. 2025 – 08. 02. 2026

Enrolment conditions are determined by Articles 13 and 14 of the Study and Examination Rules for students of CTU, and Article 3 of the currently valid guideline for the implementation of bachelor's and master's study programmes.

From 08.12.2025 to 08.02.2026, enrolment in bachelor's and master's study programmes for the summer semester of the academic year 2025-2026 will take place through the KOS system.

Mandatory enrolment dates are set out in the following table.

Summary information and warnings:

Students in the 1st year of the bachelor's study programme must obtain the minimum of 15 credits from study in the 1st semester. Students in the 1st year of the master's study programme must obtain the minimum of 20 credits from study in 1st semester.

If the student has not obtained the number of credits required to continue his studies, he cannot be enrolled in the next semester of study and his studies will be terminated. The study will also be terminated for a student who has not enrolled and not closed his enrolment within the set deadline. A student can apply for a postponement of the date of enrolment in the study if he does not have a sufficient number of credits, but always on the condition that he obtains the missing credits during the deferral period to continue his studies by successfully completing one missing subject.

Subjects of the previous summer semester, which the student did not successfully complete, can be enrolled a second time. Each subject can only be enrolled twice.
